

# Old Brooklyn Connected Wi-Fi Device Setup

## Wi-Fi Device Mounting Bracket Setup

1. Remove all the parts from the box.
2. The window mounting bracket is put together with the enclosed screw. See pictures below.

3. For the best performance, it is recommended to install the device on a window closest to the access point outside. To install, press the suction cup against the window, and press down the lever. See below:

## Wi-Fi Device Setup

1. In order to plug in the cables for the device, you must remove the panel.
2. Push in the clip on the back or bottom, and slide the panel off. See below.

3. Plug in one of the network cables into the network jack labeled “LAN”.
4. Replace panel.

5. Slide the device onto the bracket.

6. For more permanent installation, place small cover plate in position on mounting bracket and secure with small black screw provided in small ziploc bag.
7. Now take the power adapter, see below, plug it into a power outlet.
8. Plug the other end of the cable coming from the device into the port labeled POE on the power adapter.

9. Take the other network cable, plug one end into the port labeled LAN on the power adapter.
10. You will then have two cables plugged into the power adapter.

11. Plug the cable coming from the jack “LAN” into the network port on your laptop or desktop computer.
